### READING PROGRAM

Our reading program runs 6 weeks, from July 1 - August 9. Signups have started, and paper reading logs will be available June 26th.

#### Babies & toddlers 0-2

Goal: 5 minutes per day/ 5 days a week (150 minutes total)

#### 3-5 year olds

10 minutes per day / 5 days a week (300 minutes total)

#### 6-12 year olds

Goal: 20 minutes per day/ 5 days a week (600 minutes total)

*Eligible for Super Reader Honor Books! Reading logs must be turned in by August 4th to be eligible for the Super Reader program.*

Activity challenges will be provided that can substitute for up to two days' worth of reading every week. Parents and caregivers of children who have alternative reading needs may adjust their goals accordingly.
